What About Underground Services In Islip Town?

I spoke to Islip Town's Deputy Commissioner, Mr. Steven Rizzo regarding the underground services. Mr. Rizzo informed me that under the Subdivision and Land Development Regulations of Islip Town, that ALL minor subdivisions, major subdivisions, and road opening sites require the installation of underground utilities. So, to be on the safe side before installing a new service in the Town of Islip, you should get an approval from the Building Department. You can't look around and go by that the whole neighborhood is overhead, that's okay to install an overhead service. I would like to thank Mr. Rizzo for his help and cooperation with this matter.

Peconic Division holds it's monthly meeting on the second Tuesday of each month. Meeting starts at 7:30pm

For the next few meetings, we will be going over the New York State Building Code. In April, we will have a short seminar on Photo Voltaic Systems. What is not covered during this meeting will be completed at our free monthly code class on April 21, 2004 at the VFW Hall. Both photo voltaic seminars will be instructed by our Inspector Jerry Flaherty.

1. Please pay attention to Lipa Drawing D22 for distances of electric meter and gas meter plumbing.

2. When wiring pools and hot tubs, pulling your wires in, make sure that you don't tape the equipment ground green or your neutral wires white for #6 and smaller [NEC 200-6 & 250-119 (a) 680-25 (a) & (b)]

3. Before you wire under counter lighting check NEC 411-4 and know some wiring methods are not allowed:

All Class 1 (Article 725) wiring is Chapter 3 wiring methods only. Also be careful not to mix Class 1 and Class 2 & 3 in the same enclosures without checking Article 725-26 and 725-54 (Separation of Class Wiring).
