And if we don't have to go back to re-inspect, you might save some money and lots of frustration. But to do this we need three things:

1. WHERE IS THE JOB? Not only do we need to know the town village and address, but also the correct zip code is a plus. We need to know if it's street, avenue, road, etc. We also need the cross streets. Some streets are quite long or interrupted by train tracks, highways, whatever.

2. WHAT SHOULD BE INSPECTED? We can count the switches, receptacles and fixtures, but we don't know if we should inspect the air condition unit, a steamer and any other equipment unless you tell us. We sometimes have to go back to the same job because we weren't told exactly what to inspect.

3. WHERE WAS THE WORK DONE? Should we inspect the kitchen, one or two bedrooms on the 2nd floor, the pool etc.? It always amazes me when a homeowner who just paid \$50-60,000.00 or more and doesn't know where the work was done or what was done.

Just taking a few minutes to give us this information will reward you with better service, less errors on the inspection certificate and less hassle with the building departments.
